

RECYCLED FIBRES AT DSB IN TAASTRUP

After considering the long term sustainability of their company DSB (Danish Railway Company) moved out of their legendary buildings in Sølvgade, Copenhagen to relocate to a new 25,000m² headquarters in Taastrup.

One of the major decisions to be made during the move was the office flooring where the demand for comfort, acoustics and ergonomics were as important as the need for a sustainable solution.

The solution came from danfloor, who in recent years have come to the fore of textile floorings and have refined the technology of using recycled fibres.

DSB chose 17.300 SQM of danfloor's Eco Weave carpet – a woven broadloom which uses recycled nylon fibre, Econyl® from Aquafil's production in Slovenia. The raw materials for Econyl® are refined fibres from used carpets, carpets tiles and other nylon fibre surplus products such as old fishing nets.



danfloor's Eco collection also includes micro tufted designs with tiles and broadloom; Eco Tiles, Eco Trend and Eco Style. The textile solutions with latex backing have been installed in offices and auditoriums.
